## Spiced Hot Chocolate Cookies

Ingredients for 12 cookies

1 cup brown sugar
1/2 cup white sugar
2 eggs
1 stick butter
4 oz unsweetened chocolate
1 cup flour
1/2 cup cocoa powder
1 1/4 teaspoons baking soda
1 tablespoon cinnamon
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon chili powder
1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper, optional
1/2 cup chocolate chips
12 large marshmallows

#### Preparation

- 1. Beat brown sugar, white sugar, and eggs.
- 2. Melt the unsweetened chocolate and butter, allow to cool. Mix into the egg and sugar mixture.
- 3. Add all of the dry ingredients, and mix thoroughly (you don't want any cayenne pepper clumps!).
  - 4. Stir in the chocolate chips.
  - 5. Space out 12 cookies on a baking sheet.
  - 6. Bake at 350°F (180°C) for 13 minutes. Remove the cookies from the oven.
    - 7. Top each one with a large marshmallow.
  - 8. Broil for 30 seconds, until the marshmallows have just started to brown.
    - 9. Enjoy!


