



Anne Romagnoli's love for the accordion, an instrument some would call oldfashioned but one that is still widely used throughout the world to play both popular and folk music, earned her the title Chicagoland's First Lady of

Accordions.

Romagnoli, owner of Italo-American Accordion Manufacturing, died Friday at the age of 90, the Chicago Tribune reported. Her family said she suffered from heart and lung diseases but was working until the day before she died.

Italo-American Accordion Manufacturing, located on 95th Street in Oak Lawn, is widely considered to be the oldest accordion store in the country. Romagnoli's parents bought the accordion manufacturing and repair business in 1910 after they immigrated from Piatanesi, a coastal Italian town known as the capital of accordion-making.

She and her husband, Joe, took over the company in 1950, and the couple also ran the Republic Music School of Chicago for several years. She taught many students to play the accordion and formed competitive bands.

When Joe died in 1995, his wife started running the business on her own at age 65.

She was able to keep the company running despite declining interest in the instrument (Romagnoli reportedly blamed the Beatles and rock music for that) and the increased popularity of online shopping.

# Music Elements Teachers Public Performances

The band John Anthony plays with, <u>Grits and Groceries Orchestra</u>, is going down to Memphis Tennessee for the first week of February. In October of 2016 they competed in the Boston Blues Challenge and won, so this win gives them a spot to compete in the International Blues Challenge. Every year the Blues Foundation puts on the International Blues Challenge where over 150 bands come from all around the world for a four day competition that takes place on the legendary Beale street in Memphis. Kemp Dunn and Robert Lyons of GGO competed in the IBC in 1997 with their band Thea Movers and won. They were the last Boston band to win. Charlie O'Neal's band the Delta Generators competed in the IBC in 2009 and were the last band from Boston to be top 10 finalists. "We are confident they will do well in Memphis and hopefully can bring home the win".
