Multiinstrumentalist, composer, and educator, Matt





Estabrook has always excelled beyond the boundaries of conventional musicianship. As a saxophonist, Matt shared the stage with legends such as Dave Holland and Miguel Zenon, and opened for acts as prolific as Earth, Wind, & Fire. Primarily teaching saxophone and flute, Matt is also highly skilled teaching voice, clarinet, guitar, as well as bass guitar, operating in styles ranging from classical to jazz and pop. Under his tutelage, Matt's students have been admitted to prestigious music programs such as the Boston Arts Academy high school. Matt has hundreds of hours of teacher training as a teaching fellow for both Breakthrough New York and the New England Conservatory of Music's Community Performance Program. Matt holds a Bachelor's of Music in Jazz Saxophone Performance from NEC, and a Bachelor's of Science in Cognitive & Brain Science from Tufts University — he takes education seriously and strives to make a fun, relevant, and productive learning environment for all!

Have you heard of this?

The Glass Harmonica: Also known as the glass armonica, glass harmonium, bowl organ, hydrocrystalophone, or simply the armonica or harmonica

Invented by Benjamin Franklin, this instrument uses the same principal as playing wine glasses but turns it on its side. A series of glass bowls rotates while the player simply touches the bowls with wet fingers to create the desired notes. Because of its unique design, multiple notes can be played at once creating some hauntingly beautiful sounds. It was quite popular in its day, in fact, some of the great composers such as Mozart and Beethoven arranged pieces to include the glass harmonica, but sadly its popularity has dwindled over time.


