

recipe of the month

(the best) Chocolate Chip Cookies

A perfect balance between chewy, crispy, flavorful, and classic, this cookie recipe is the perfect addition to your holiday table. Be careful with how many of these you leave out for Santa, though-- the plate will be wiped clean by the morning! Recipe adapted from Claire Saffitz.

Ingredients:

Yields approx. 18 large cookies.

- 2 sticks unsalted butter
- 2 tbsp heavy cream, half-and-half, or whole milk
- 2 cups all purpose flour
- 2 tsp kosher salt
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 3/4 cup packed dark brown sugar
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar

- 2 large eggs
- 1 tbsp vanilla extract
- 5 oz dark chocolate disks, half coarsely chopped
- 5 oz milk chocolate disks, half coarsely chopped

Directions:

- 1. In a small saucepan, cook 1 stick of the butter over medium-low heat, frequently stirring until the butter starts to bubble. Continue to cook, scraping the bottom and sides of the pan constantly with a heat-proof spatula, until the butter browns. Make sure to take the pan off the heat as soon as the butter turns amber-colored-- it burns easily!
- 2. Add the browned butter to the bowl with the other (cold) stick of butter, making sure you scrape in all of the browned bits, then add the heavy cream (no need to stir). Set aside to cool.
- 3. In a medium bowl, whisk together the flour, salt, and baking soda. Set aside.
- 4. Add the brown and granulated sugars to the butter bowl-- it can be slightly warm, just not hot-- and whisk vigorously until the mixture is smooth and thick, about 45 seconds. Add the eggs and vanilla and whisk until the mixture is satiny, about 45 seconds.
- 5. Add the flour mixture and whisk until the batter is sooth and well combined. It will look a little loose-- this is normal. Switch to a flexible spatula to scrape down the bowl, folding to ensure everything is incorporated.
- 6. Add all of the chocolates and mix to combine. Cover the batter tightly with plastic wrap and refrigerate for 12-48 hours.
- 7. When you're ready to bake, preheat the oven to 350 degrees and line two rimmed baking sheets with parchment paper. Place 6, 1/4-cup sized cookie dough balls on each sheet, ensuring that they are at least 3 inches apart.
- 8. Bake the cookies (2 sheets at a time, on upper and lower racks) for 18-22 minutes, until they are dark golden brown around the edges. Let cookies rest for 5 minutes on baking sheets after cooking, then transfer to a wire rack to cool. Repeat until all cookies are baked. Enjoy!
